# Year 7 Autumn Term 2:



#### **Ancient Tales**

During this half term, we are going to read six short stories classed as ancient tales. We will study the stories and learn how to extract information from them (AO1) and will also understand how the writer has used language and structural methods in order to have an effect on the reader (AO2). We will also use the stories to focus on developing our own writing skills.

We will develop our learning each week by focusing on:

Retrieval Knowledge: Recap different language and structural techniques.

Knowledge: Learn what ancient tales are and how they are important. Read 'The Cheetah's Whisker.'

**Skills: English Language Reading:** AO1 & AO2 (Analyse the character of Abeba in 'The Cheetah's Whisker').

## Week 2 Key Learning

Retrieval Knowledge: Freytag's pyramid; use of apostrophes.

Knowledge: Read a retelling of 'Hansel and Gretel' by Carol-Ann Duffy.

Skills: English Language Reading: AO1 & AO2 (Analyse how Duffy uses language to create a sense of

vulnerability in the children).

Skills: English Language Writing: AO5 (Clear and Imaginative Communication) & AO6 (SPAG): write a

story about a vulnerable character.

### Week 3 Key Learning

Retrieval Knowledge: Recap

Knowledge: Read 'Two Dinners' and 'The Giant's Causeway'.

Skills: English Language Reading: AO1 and AO2 (Analyse how language and structure have been used

to create memorable characters.

## Week 4 Key Learning

Retrieval Knowledge: Recap how Finn Mac Cumhail and Bre Anansi are memorable characters.

**Knowledge:** What makes a memorable character. How to punctuate dialogue.

**Skills: English Language Writing:** AO5 (Clear and Imaginative Communication) & AO6 (SPAG): write a story about a memorable character beginning with dialogue and action.

Mini assessment: Complete a mini assessment 'The Cheetah's Whisker.'

**Skills: English Language Reading:** How does the writer use language and structure to show that Abeba misses her mother?(AO1 and 2).

Week 5 Key Learning

Retrieval Knowledge: Knowledge of how semi-colons are used.

**Knowledge:** Read 'The Wicked King and his Good Son'; use of semi-colons.

Skills: English Language Reading: AO1, AO2: compare how the writer uses language and structure to

create two contrasting characters.

Skills: English Language Writing: AO5 (Clear and Imaginative Communication) & AO6 (SPAG): write a

description of a wicked character.

Retrieval Knowledge: How to analyse an extract to prepare for final assessment.

**Knowledge:** Read 1001 Arabian Nights. Preparation for final assessment.

**Skills: English Language Reading:** AO1, AO2: compare how the writer uses language and structure to create a good character (Shahrazad).
