#### What will you be learning about?

# How will this help you in the future?

#### Key Stage 4

## Beyond Lode Heath School

English is the language of communication (and international communication); it is fundamental in accessing education and society so that you can participate and thrive as a full member of your community. You speak and write fluently so that you can clearly and effectively communicate your ideas, thoughts and emotions to others.

If you go on to student English at Key Stage 5 and then university, this unit will help you in ALL of your GCSE English language and literature units because you need to know, analyse, evaluate and apply the use of writer's methods in EVERY unit of work you study beyond GCSE.

#### **Future Careers**

**Advertising copywriter;** they decide the words used for print, TV, radio and online adverts (£20,000 to £80,000); there will be 1.4% more advertising copywriter jobs in 2028.

**Broadcast journalist**; they research and present the news on TV, radio and the internet (£23,000 to £42,000); there will be 3.6% more broadcast journalist jobs in 2028.

**Crown prosecutor**; they decide if there's enough evidence to take cases to court (£41,000 to £65,000); there will be 3.6% crown prosecutor jobs in 2028.

**Marketing manager**; they plan how to promote products, services or brands and oversee all marketing activity (£30,000 to £65,000); there will be 3.6% marketing manager jobs in 2028.

**Speech and language therapist**; they help people with speaking and communication problems (£31,000 to £55,00); there will be 2.8% more speech and language therapist jobs in 2028.
