



## **Year 8 German: Unit 4 – Food and shopping**

### **Topic(s) to be covered**

This term students will explore the following topics: Food at the market, buying fruit and vegetables, quantities and prices in Euros, at the café, food and opinions using ich esse gern, ich trinke gern. Cultural capital – Easter in German speaking countries. Students will develop their skills by reading and listening for cognates and use simple phrases to respond to questions about themselves.

### **Assessment Procedures**

1. Speaking assessment – Students will prepare responses to five questions and have to answer three of those questions in their assessment.

### **Homework guidance**

Students will receive a minimum of one homework per week for which they will be expected to spend a minimum of 20 minutes completing. The homework will usually be to learn key vocabulary or complete listening and reading tasks on [www.languageut.com](http://www.languageut.com). If there are upcoming assessments, revision homework may be set.

**In cases where homework has not been completed, MFL teachers may grant a day extension. If the homework is still not completed following this extension, this will result in a 25 minute after school detention.**

### **How can you help?**

Encourage your child to download the Duolingo app which supports German language learning. Student can also use the platform on which their homework is set to learn extra vocabulary.
