



Topic(s) to be covered.

This term students will explore the following topics: Family members, adjectives and descriptions, describing relationships and getting on with family, friendships. Students will develop their skills by reading for gist and listening for cognates and use more complex phrases to respond to questions about free time.

Assessment Procedures

1. **Interim assessment** - part way through topic based on topics that have already been covered.

Homework guidance

Students will receive a minimum of one homework per week for which they will be expected to spend a minimum of 30 minutes completing. The homework will usually be to learn key vocabulary or complete listening and reading tasks on www.languageut.com. If there are upcoming assessments, revision homework may be set.

In cases where homework has not been completed, MFL teachers may grant a day extension. If the homework is still not completed following this extension, this will result in a 25 minute after school detention.
