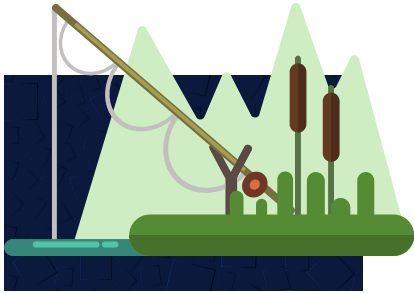




# Year 7 Geography
